The reading of the 3/14/16 Minutes from last year's annual meeting was waived.

Treasure's Report – Director Berman discussed the financial state of the community. There was \$2400 in unplanned expenses for Telephones throughout the neighborhood in 2016. The phone lines were connected to the Fire Alarm systems, which were converted to wireless receivers in 2015. We anticipated having all lines cancelled before the new budget went into effect on January 1 but Collier County's fire inspectors took longer than anticipated to sign off on the new systems, allowing us to cancel the old landlines. We had many line items run over budget, and many others run under budget, allowing us to finish under budget overall in each sub association.

Secretary's Report – Director Scuteri explained the rental procedures to those in attendance. She explained that the board looks over each application and background check before rentals are approved. This season there were 22 total rentals 5 of those are annual rentals.

Election of Officers – Marlene Berman ran unopposed for her seat on the board, so no election was needed.
